REVIEW MEETING

Main point of discussion: R vs Python

- ECMWF prefers Python, in particular for those tools that can work directly on the portal
- The download of software by the user should be avoided if possible
- We will still do the QC in R, while the formatting tools will be in Python.
- For the metadata QC we should ask ECMWF (probably better to involve Lot 2 – Simon Noone)

QC SOFTWARE

We currently have 3 different sets of QC software:

- UERRA (hourly and daily)
- ERA-CLIM (hourly and daily)
- DECADE (daily)

Question: Does it makes sense to provide different software to do the same thing? Should we somehow merge them into a single tool? Is this feasible at all?

DIGITISATION PORTAL

NIWA will develop a digitisation portal (OldWeather-like).

The idea is that we will take over this portal (probably in a couple of years) and further develop it so that it can handle different projects (i.e., the «Job dispatch system» that is in the list of our tools).

Hopefully B-Open will still be on board and take care of this. NIWA (Drew Lorrey) has been advised to get in touch with B-Open whenever they will start to work on the portal, in order to facilitate a future transition.
