## C3S GENERAL ASSEMBLY

- **General remarks**
  - Peter Thorne asked to remove ISTI and other already digitized data from the registry to avoid inconsistencies with Lot 2 metadata; we think that the registry should be mainly beneficial to data rescuers, not to Lot 2. Antonia will discuss this with Peter T.
  - The arrival server of Lot 2 will be activated soon
  - ECMWF might be allowed to mint WIGOS IDs for C3S
- **Next contract phase**
  - Should Lot 1 and Lot 2 be merged?
  - Global images repository possible item for next contract
- **DRS visibility on Copernicus**
  - DRS currently not reachable from main C3S website. But it will be officially launched this February

- The aim of the staging portal is keeping this portal always in a functional state, to test functionalities before the 'real' use in the production portal.

## NEW DATARESQC RELEASE

- dataresqc v0.1.2 available on GitHub (<https://github.com/c3s-data-rescue-service/dataresqc>)
- No additional functions but several minor bugs fixed
- Tested on a large dataset, could detect 1 in 5 digitization errors for pressure, 1 in 13 for temperature (without the visual tools).
- Time to submit to CRAN (probably within 1-2 months)
