UPDATES ON UPCOMING DELIVERABLES

- **Annual State of Data Rescue Assessment Report (due this month)**
 - Currently extracting statistics from I-DARE portal
 - Yuri will send around a draft early next week
- **Best Practice Guidelines 2 (due in March)**
 - Sent to external reviewers, reviews expected in early January
- **User Support: Blog Forum and Ticketing System (due in March)**
 - Ticketing system has to be implemented on the portal (add a page similar to that for the forum with link to C3S “centralized” ticketing system)
 - A short report will be expected
- **Software Tools (due in March)**
 - Need a section on the portal, to be discussed with B-Open

SEF 1.0

- SEF documentation has been updated (the format itself is unchanged):

- Main changes:

- no length limit for station ID (previously WIGOS limit)

- daily data: the hour “24” is allowed for midnight-to-midnight time frames

2019	12	11	24	0	day
------	----	----	----	---	-----

instead of

2019	12	12	0	0	day
------	----	----	---	---	-----

to avoid shift of the date

- monthly data: give NA in Day column (instead of last day of each month)

- annual data: give NA in Month column
