* Numbers are going to increase in the coming months

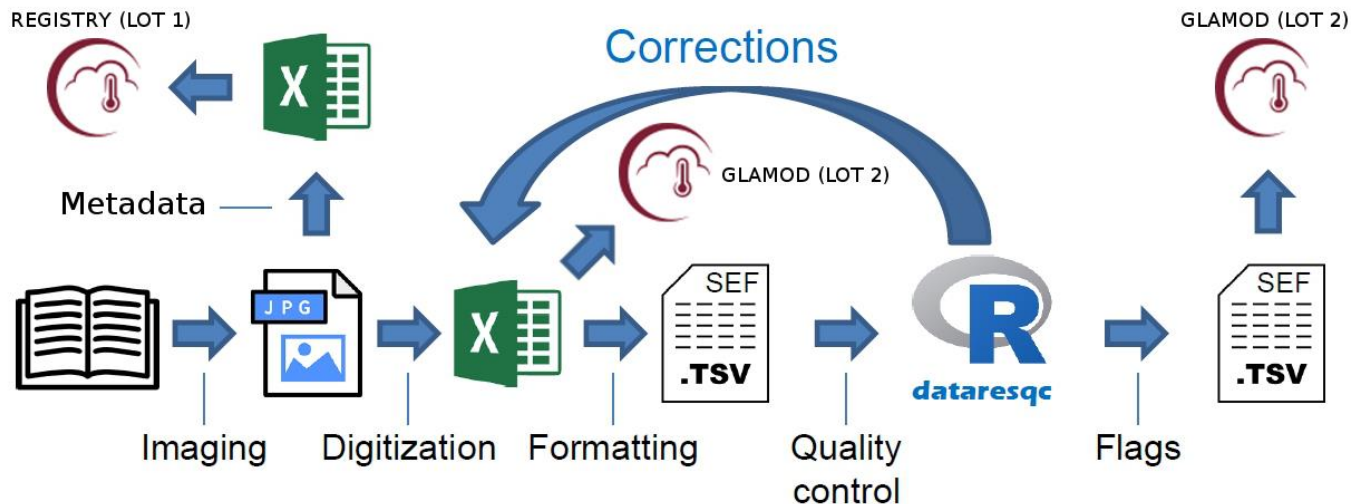
- Marine data will come mostly from NIWA (currently organizing IMMA formatting with Drew)

Updates on Copernicus 2.0, next phase for in situ data

In late March we had the second interlot meeting with ECMWF and other lots, at this meeting Carlo Buontempo gave us an update on next phase for C3S for in situ contracts, discussions with the Commission were very fluid at the time, but with COVID-19 and Brexit creating uncertainty in the timing and the budget.

A draft proposal was in progress at this time, with expected completion by July. Hans noted the deliverables to date on the recommendations from Lots 2 and 3 are valuable inputs in this process.

Given the delays to contract commencement the **Commission have been discussing the possibility of extending for a finite period critical contracts with ECMWF.** It is unclear at this state whether this would happen and if so whether our contract would be amongst those to be extended.
